

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Fat Pig Vineyard Limited** is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 177 Puketotara Road, Kerikeri 0295, Far North District and known as "**Fat Pig Vineyard**", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day. However, a person may sell or deliver grape wine or fruit wine on Easter Sunday if the grape wine or fruit wine is made –
- (i) On the premises; or
 - (ii) From grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
MONDAY TO SUNDAY 11.00 am to 8.00 pm
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises and signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.
- (d) Each of the following parts of the premises is designated as a **supervised area**: sale counter, display and storage.
- (e) Sales may include internet and mail ordered sales. An exemption from the trading hour restrictions for remote sales of alcohol applies and may be made at any time on any day. (Section 49 (1) refers) subject to the following condition:
- No Delivery Permitted On: Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1:00pm on Anzac Day.
- (f) A copy of the licence or a clearly identified link to such an image must be displayed in a prominent place on the internet site.
- (g) The following information must be displayed on the internet site in a prominent place and in any catalogue used by the license holder and on every receipt issued for any alcohol sold via the internet site:
- The licence holders name, the licence number and the date on which the licence expires
- (h) The following steps must be taken to verify that people are over the purchase age:
- In the case of an order made using an internet site or telephone order the prospective buyer must make a declaration that he or she is 18 years of age or over and that the prospective receiver is also 18 years of age or over
- (i) The applicant must take all reasonable steps to ensure that any courier delivery company used by the applicant has internal policies in place to satisfy the object of the Act including:
- that all deliveries containing alcohol are duly authorised by the correct recipient and that;
 - Proof of age is verified if required.
 - No deliveries are to be simply left at the recipient's address
- (j) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

THE LICENCED PREMISES

The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised in of from the premises generally. The premises, situated at 177 Puketotara Road, Kerikeri 0295, Far North District, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Far North District Licensing Committee on 22 November 2019.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The principal entrance is the car park adjacent to the premises.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) either -
- i. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either-
- i. Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
